

Winter Hose Hooks

About five months of the year the barn hoses live in the office pretty much day and night.

These hose hooks are set just above shoulder height, so, even when empty, they don't seem like much of a threat.



For these hose hooks, use three-quarter-inch plywood, some scrap 2x4, glue and screws, with two of three-inch drywall screws to hang each hook into a wall-stud. The hoses don't sag into kinks as they rest on the hooks, and, since there is space between the plywood arms on each hook, it's quite easy to fit a hand into that space to pick the hoses up and set them back.

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
